Main Reports:

- Balance Sheet depicts what the District owns and what the District owes.
- Profit & Loss Budget Performance shows how the District is performing against the budget, and the condition of the District fiscal year to date.
- Capital Detail shows activity pertaining to Capital Projects.

Balance Sheet:

The District's combined Cash with Chase Bank, Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF), and California Cooperative Liquid Assets Securities System (CLASS) balance was \$1,947,585 at month end. The District's total liabilities were approximately \$554,494 at month end.

Profit and Loss: - Year to date (YTD) is 92% of the year

- 4. Commodity Sales: Volumetric water sales including residential, commercial & construction water sales. YTD is in trending under budget at 80% due to a decrease in water consumption due to heavy rain season.
- 7. Basic Facilities Fee: These are fees charged for new service connections, meter installations, and upgrades. These revenues are budgeted conservatively due to their unpredictable nature. YTD is over budget due to multiple service installations.
- 9. Total Operating Income: YTD is at 88%.
- 11. Property Taxes: This account includes Ad Valorem tax revenues apportioned by Riverside County. Property Tax receipts are typically received in January and May when property tax payments are due to the County of Riverside Tax Collector's Office. This year, the bulk of receipts will be received in June. YTD is trending under budget at 64%. 15. Interest Income-Investment Accounts: This account includes interest earnings in the District's LAIF and other
- investment accounts. YTD is over budget due to higher interest rates.
- 26. Total Payroll: YTD is at 90%.
- 30. Meter Testing & Repair: This account includes the costs of meter repairs and meter testing. Expenses vary throughout the year. YTD is trending under budget at 33%.
- 37. Total Facilities, Wells, T&D: YTD is at 65%.
- 49. Total Office Expenses: YTD is at 82%.
- 51. Financial Audit: This account includes the costs for the annual financial audit. YTD is trending under budget at 57% due to timing of audit expenses.
- 53. Legal Services: This account includes the costs of legal services for the District. YTD will vary depending upon the requirement and timing of legal services. YTD is trending under budget at 26%.
- 57. Total Support Services: YTD is at 82%.
- 61. Shop Supplies & Small Tools: This account includes various shop supply and small tool purchases. YTD is trending under budget at 55%.
- 62. Vehicle Fuel: This account includes fuel costs for District vehicles. YTD is over budget due to higher fuel expenses than anticipated.
- 67. Service Trucks Repair & Maintenance (R&M): This account includes repair & maintenance costs for District vehicles. YTD is trending under budget at 53% due to less maintenance than anticipated.
- 69. Total Service Tools & Equipment: YTD is at 62%.
- 71. Loan Interest & Processing Fee: This account includes Department of Water Resources (DWR) interest expense, DWR loan processing fees, and Ford interest expense. DWR payments are made in October and April. YTD is over budget due to loan origination fees in October and April relating to the Well 4 loan.

- 74. Damaged Truck/Stolen Tools: This account contains expenses for damaged trucks and stolen tools. Activity in this account includes an \$11.3k payment to replace locks, handles, and paint on a truck that was damaged during theft.
- 75. Grant Application Share of Cost: This account includes \$12K paid to the City of Banning for Proposition 1 Round 2 grant application for the replacement of outdated waterlines.
- 76. Total Non-Operating Expenses: YTD is at 244%.
- 77. Total Expenses: YTD is at 83%.

As of May 31st, the fiscal year-to-date net income is \$615,381.

Capital Detail:

- 7. Bonita Vault: This account is for new vault and materials. YTD is trending under budget at 39% due to timing of project completion.
- 15. Esperanza Waterline Improvements: Includes the Esperanza Waterline project which is expected to be primarily grant funded with the project costing \$359,700 and the grant funding being \$343,700.
- 18. Groundwater Well Improvements: Includes the Groundwater Well Improvements project, expected to be 100% grant funded. Cash flow relating to grant receipts to be supported by SGPWA Gap Funding. YTD is trending under budget at 2% due to timing of improvements.



July 16, 2024 CWD Board Meeting Operations Update

- The new Crown Castle Cell Tower Agreement was signed and notarized on June 20, 2024. A \$5,000.00 signing bonus will be distributed 60 days after final closing of the agreement. On July 1, 2028, the annual rent shall increase to (10%) of the annual rent, followed by a (2%) annual increase each year until July1, 2048.
- The Esperanza Pipeline Project is scheduled to start July 29, 2024 by G & A Nelos Construction.@ \$245,579.00, Grant funding is for \$343,700.
- Bonita Vault –Jensen Precast is constructing the Vault (\$28,062.41) with the projected delivery date of August 6, 2024. Crane services may be provided by Mr. Crane estimate is \$5,112.80. A deposit in the amount of \$13,022.00 has been received by Jensen, and has started the manufacturing of the vault. Materials in the amount of \$20,509.89 from Western Water has been delivered on July 2, 2024. Survey Services performed by Hillwig- Goodrow for \$2,290.00, was completed on June 17, 2024.
- General Manager and SEIU 721 Union Worksite Organizer Juanita Salas met via zoom with Cabazon Water District employees Dave Wolny and Clay Morgan regarding re alignment of the correct job description (Water Technician II) to the proper salary range of Water Technician II. Both Clay Morgan and Dave Wolny are currently both over the maximum salary range of Water Technician II. Previously both Dave and Clay were promoted to Field Lead, and both voluntarily step down, and reassigned to their previous position of Water Technician II. A second item discussed was the position filled by James Dowling who is the most talented, diplomatic, recommends strategies to improve operations, prepare for future growth and the most qualified employee. The MOU states that any opening position in a classification above the entry level, notice shall be posted in the district office. However, the current staff that was promoted to a position with higher levels of responsibilities was selected and promoted with no job posting. Clay was selected 8/12/2018 and voluntarily stepped down on 8/6/2019. Dave was selected on 1/20/2020 and voluntarily stepped down on 1/21/2021. Ellen was selected as a lead and is still going strong. All with no job postings.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-02

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CABAZON WATER DISTRICT FIXING WATER STANDBY ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31032.1 of the California Water Code, the Board of Directors of the Cabazon Water District (hereinafter "District") is authorized to annually fix water standby or water availability assessments not to exceed \$30.00 per acre per year for each acre of land, or \$30.00 per year for each parcel of land equal to or less than one acre, to which water is made available for any purpose by the District, whether the water is actually used or not; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found that the very existence of publicly available water through a public agency is of benefit to the lands to be assessed; and

WHEREAS, the water standby assessments are hereby dedicated to lawful purposes of the District, and will be available to pay the District's long-term indebtedness and for other lawful purposes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 31032.1 and 31032.2 the Board of Directors may elect to have the standby or availability assessments collected on the tax rolls after a written report of water standby assessments for fiscal year 2024-2025 is prepared; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors elects to have the standby and availability assessments collected on the tax rolls, and, therefore, finds it necessary that a written report of the water standby assessments for the 2024-2025 fiscal year be prepared, and that certain criteria be established to assist the General Manager in the preparation of said written report as it pertains to those parcels of property located within the District's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the standby and availability assessments for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year are exempt from Proposition 218 because they do not exceed the rates levied in the 1996-1997 Fiscal Year and the assessments generate revenue for both 1) the operation and maintenance of a water system and 2) the payment of bonded indebtedness; and

WHEREAS, the District previously caused a report to be prepared and filed with the secretary of the District, describing each parcel of real property and the amount of the assessment for each parcel for the 2024-2025 fiscal year (the "Report"), which report has been on file with the secretary as required under Water Code section 31032.1, and by this reference is incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, upon filing the Report, the District provided notice as required under Water Code section 31032.2, notifying all interested persons that said Report has been filed, and of the time and place for a public hearing on said Report and the placement of the standby and availability assessments for collection on the property tax roll by the County; and

WHEREAS, at the public hearing called for such purpose, the Board of Directors heard and considered all protests and objections to collection of the standby and availability assessments on the tax roll; and

WHEREAS, at this time, the Board of Directors wishes to overrule all objections, adopt the Report as drafted, subject to any appropriate adjustments that may be necessary as a result of the equalization of the assessment roll subsequent to the date hereof, as authorized under Water Code section 31032.3. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cabazon County Water District as follows:

- 1. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct, and by this reference incorporated herein.
- 2. Having heard and considered all protests and objections filed or made prior to the end of the public hearing, the Board of Directors hereby overrules all such protests or objections adopts the Report, which was prepared with the following criteria:

Assessments are made without regard to property valuation, and each parcel is hereby classified into one of three zones, with the standby or availability assessment rate for each zone set as follows:

ZONE A: The area within the base water service pressure zone as shown by map on file at the District office.

Each parcel that has an active metered service connection shall be assessed a water availability assessment of \$10.00 per parcel for each parcel equal to or less than one acre or \$10.00 per acre for which there is an active metered service capacity unit (for assessment purposes, one active metered service capacity unit is equivalent to one acre; see Exhibit "A", attached) plus \$30.00 per acre or portion thereof for each acre or portion thereof in excess of the acreage represented by active metered service capacity units.

Each parcel that does not have an active metered service connection shall be assessed a water standby assessment of \$30.00 per parcel for each parcel equal to or less than one acre or \$30.00 per acre or portion thereof for each parcel greater than one acre.

ZONE B: The area within other water service pressure zones and three Property Types as shown by map on file at District Office. The standby assessment rate for Zone B and each Property Type therein is hereby set as follows:

<u>PROPERTY TYPE 1:</u> Any parcel that is not served by the District through an active meter and has slopes of up to 15% will be assessed \$15.00 per acre or portion thereof within Zone B for that portion of the parcel with described slopes.

PROPERTY TYPE 2: Any parcel that is not served by the District through an active meter and has slopes of between 15% and 25% will be assessed \$10.00 per acre or portion thereof within Zone B for that portion of the parcel with described slopes.

PROPERTY TYPE 3: Any parcel that is not served by the District through an active meter and has slopes greater than 25% will be assessed \$5.00 per acre or portion thereof within Zone B for that portion of the parcel with described slopes.

ZONE C: Each parcel within Riverside County Surface Mining Permit No. 162 shall be assessed \$30.00 per acre or portion thereof.

3. The General Manager, or his or her designee, is hereby authorized to make any appropriate adjustments to the Report that may be necessary as a result of the equalization of the assessment roll subsequent to this public hearing. The General Manager, or his or her designee, is hereby directed to file the Report, as adjusted, with the auditor for the County of Riverside on or prior to the 16th day of August, 2024. The standby and availability assessments shall be collected on the tax bills for the parcels identified in the Report and shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner and by the same persons as, together with and not separately from, general taxes, and shall be delinquent at the same time and thereafter be subject to the same delinquency penalties to be levied on and collected from the owners of said parcels



Dear Mr. Benoit:

Cabazon Water District represents that the charges associated with property tax district number 68-4815 identified on the county Tax Roll as Cabazon County Water Standby is in compliance with the articles of article XIII D of the California Constitution (added as part of Proposition 218) cited below.

The County Auditor-Controller/County of Riverside agrees to enter all assessments, fees, charges, or taxes for Cabazon Water District upon receipt of such roll on or about August 16, 2024 based upon such certification.

Cabazon Water District shall be solely liable and responsible, and will defend, indemnify and hold the County and this office harmless from any liability as a result of claims or claims for refunds and related interest due filed by taxpayers against any assessments, fees, charges, or taxes placed on the roll for Cabazon Water District by the County.

The Cabazon County Standby Charges are assessments for the purpose of article XIII D of the California Constitution, as provided for in article XIII D, section 6(b)(4). Article XIII D, section 5 of the California Constitution provides in relevant part:

"Beginning July 1, 1997, all existing, new, or increased assessments shall comply with this article. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the following assessments existing on the effective date of this article shall be exempt...(1) Any assessment imposed exclusively to finance the capital costs or maintenance and operation expenses for...sewer, water, flood control, drainage systems... Subsequent increases in such assessments shall be subject to the procedures and approval process set forth in Section 4."




